We do not share, sell or rent our lists to commercial vendors or other organizations. You will not be added to any third party e-mail list without your consent.

1. What Personally Identifiable Information Do We Collect?

Personally Identifiable Information means information that tells us something about who you are, such as your name, phone number, email address, mailing address, or credit card number (for example, if you use a credit card to make a donation). We only collect personal information from you that you provide to us voluntarily.
